In 1893 he went to South Africa .There he was appalled by pathetic conditions of coloured people and discrimination against the Indians and South Africans.He fought for their rights. He adopted a new method of light against the British rulers. He practiced peaceful resistance to racial discrimination. His weapons were Sathyagrah and Ahimsa. After winning the battle in South Africa, he returned to India in 1916.
